DECREE NO. 22/2020 OF THE RECTOR OF THE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY OF GDAŃSK dated 10th March 2020

on COVID-19 spread prevention among the MUG's community

Pursuant to art. 23 sect. 2 p. 2, art. 51 sect. 1 of the Higher Education and Science Act of Law (Journal of Laws 2020, it. 85) and the Law on prevention, combat and control of COVID-19 and other infectious diseases resulting in crisis situations dated 2nd March 2020 (Journal of Laws 2020, it. 374)

I hereby decree

§1

- 1. Clinical classes (bedside) are suspended until further notice. Any change in conducting the class lies in the hands of the head of the unit upon agreement with the competent deans' office.
- 2. Lectures are now cancelled the lecturers are obliged to place all didactic materials in the Extranet no later than on the date of the lecture.
- 3. If possible it is advised to conduct classes by keeping the necessary distance between students.
- 4. Students are asked to report their deteriorating condition or symptoms of COVID-19 to the proper deans' office.
- 5. Should any student show any symptoms of a viral infection they must not attend any classes. If the absence lasts max. 7 days, a sick note is not obligatory. If the absence lasts more than 7 days the student must hand in a sick note.
- 6. The reading rooms in the Main Library are now closed.
- 7. The Sports Centre is now closed until further notice. No Physical Education classes will be conducted.
- 8. Any meetings of the Students' Scientific Circles are now suspended.
- 9. Any events, parties, meetings and conferences organised at the campus are now cancelled.
- 10. It is advised that any academic employees who came back from abroad shall work remotely during the period of two weeks upon agreement with their supervisor.
- 11. It is recommended to use emails or phone calls among employees, students and doctoral students.

- 1. This decree comes into effect on 11th March 2020.
- 2. This decree shall remain in effect until further notice.
